MOUNT JULIET TO HOST THE Credits 2025 OFX IRISH LEGENDS

The 2025 OFX Irish Legends will be hosted on the championship course in the week commencing 12th May 2025 at Mount Juliet Estate, which has previously been the venue for five Irish Open's and two World Golf Championships.

t is a first return to the Kilkenny course for the over 50's Tour since 1999, when John Morgan was victorious in the Irish Seniors Open on the European Seniors Tour - before it became the Legends Tour. The championship course at Mount Juliet Estate was designed by Jack Nicklaus and stretches up to 7,200 yards across 180 acres of land. The course provides players with plenty of challenges to avoid with five lakes, which come into play on six holes, and 80 bunkers which are strategically placed around the course.



The Legends Tour has stopped off at Seapoint Golf Links in County Louth for the last two years, where Adilson Da Silva was crowned champion of the 2024 OFX Irish Legends. He eventually claimed the 6th win of his Legends Tour career after a nail-biting play-off against Patrik Sjöland, with a birdie on the third extra hole.

Da Silva will defend his title at Mount Juliet this year in what's set to be another thrilling week in Irish golf as the event now moves to the Championship course in Kilkenny which is renowned for hosting the 2021 Dubai Duty-Free Irish Open, the 2022 Horizon Irish Open as well as earlier editions of that same event in 1993, 1994 and 1995.





Starting the day a shot behind Ryder Cup team-mate Sepp Straka, the Northern Irishman made an eagle and five birdies in a closing six-under-par 66 to finish 21 under par, a shot outside the tournament record set by American Brandt Snedeker in 2015.

laying partner Shane Lowry birdied the 18th to secure solo second on 19 under, with 2023 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am winner Justin Rose making an eagle putt with a fairway wood on the same hole to share third place with American Lucas Glover.

It is McIlroy's 27th triumph on the PGA TOUR – and first at the world-renowned California course.


"Some people would argue the golf courses I have won on are not up to a Pebble Beach or an Augusta, but to win at one of the cathedrals of golf is really, really cool," said McIlroy.


"I knew today was going to be tough, it was going to be exciting, there were so many guys around the lead and I guess with it being Pebble Beach I had to put that to the back of my mind and go out there and try to shoot a score, which I was able to. Really cool to have that walk up 18 and take it all in.

"I said to Harry [Diamond, his caddie] walking up the last, start as you mean to go on. I'm just as determined this year as in any of the years I've been out here on the PGA Tour and to get this win this early it means a great deal and hopefully just keep the momentum going into Torrey Pines in a couple of weeks' time."

Straka, who won The American Express on his last PGA TOUR start last month, carded a 72 to finish in a tie for seventh.

Four-time Major winner McIlroy moves to the top of the European Team Rankings for this year's Ryder Cup, with Lowry also in the top-six spots for automatic qualifiers after climbing to fourth.



McILROY CONFIRMED FOR AMGEN IRISH OPEN

Four-time Major winner and reigning Race to Dubai champion Rory McIlroy will return to the site of his first professional victory on Irish soil when he tees it up in the Amgen Irish Open at The K Club from September 4-7, 2025.



he Northern Irishman secured a famous victory at the County Kildare venue in 2016 after producing a stunning birdie-par-eagle finish to win the island of Ireland's national open by three strokes.

McIlroy finished his 2024 season by being crowned Race to Dubai Champion for a sixth time – and third time in succession – after winning two Rolex Series events and finishing second at the Amgen Irish Open at Royal County Down, in addition to two victories on the PGA TOUR.

The 35-year-old will return to the Amgen Irish Open later this year in the build up to the Ryder Cup at Bethpage Black, USA.

"I'm excited to be returning to The K Club for the Irish Open later this year," McIlroy said.

"Playing in the Irish Open, in front of your home fans, is always a special experience. Growing up as a kid, I have so many great memories of going to the Irish Open, soaking up the atmosphere and hoping to catch a glimpse of some of my favourite players.

The K Club has always been a fantastic venue, and I'm sure the fans will be out in force again this year. I can't wait to be a part of it and to share another amazing week with everyone there

"The support the Irish players receive is unmatched. The scenes at Royal County Down last year were unforgettable. While I unfortunately came up just short that week, the roars walking down the 18th hole and the energy from the crowd will stay with me forever.

"The K Club has always been a fantastic venue, and I'm sure the fans will be out in force again this year. I can't wait to be a part of it and to share another amazing week with everyone there."

The K Club hosted The Ryder Cup in 2006, when Ian Woosnam's European side retained their title by a record-equalling $18\frac{1}{2}$ - $9\frac{1}{2}$ defeat of the United States. A decade later, in 2016, the venue hosted the Irish Open for the first time, with McIlroy winning by three strokes.

The Amgen Irish Open once again assumes a key position on the DP World Tour's Global Schedule as part of the 'Back 9', which encompasses nine of the Tour's most historic tournaments and national opens. It will also form an important part of final preparations for some players ahead of The 2025 Ryder Cup at Bethpage, which takes place three weeks later.

At last year's event, Rasmus Højgaard beat McIlroy to the title by one stroke at Royal County Down, winning his fifth DP World Tour title and becoming the second-consecutive Scandinavian winner of the event after Vincent Norman, of Sweden, at The K Club in 2023.

Højgaard joined an esteemed roll of honour, adding his name to a list of Irish Open champions that also includes Seve Ballesteros, Nick Faldo, Pádraig Harrington, Jon Rahm, Colin Montgomerie, José María Olazábal, Bernhard Langer and Sam Torrance.

THE MASTERS 2025

A world-class line-up will descend on Augusta National for a mouth-watering contest from April 10-13 where Rory McIlroy will be hoping to claim a long overdue Major.



he first "Augusta National Invitational" Tournament, as the Masters was originally known commenced in 1934, and was won by Horton Smith, who took the first prize of \$1,500.

The Big Three of Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, and Jack Nicklaus dominated the Masters from 1960 through 1978, winning the event 11 times among them during that span. After winning by one stroke in 1958, Palmer won by one stroke again in 1960 in memorable circumstances. Trailing Ken Venturi by one shot in the 1960 event, Palmer made birdies on the last two holes to prevail. Palmer would go on to win another two Masters in 1962 and 1964.

Jack Nicklaus emerged in the early 1960's, and served as a rival to the popular Palmer. Nicklaus won his first green jacket in 1963, defeating Tony Lema by one stroke. Two years later, he shot a then-course record of 271 (17 under par) for his second Masters win, leading Bobby Jones to say that Nicklaus played "a game with which I am not familiar".

The next year, Nicklaus won his third green jacket in a grueling 18-hole play-off against Tommy Jacobs and Gay Brewer. This made Nicklaus the first player to win consecutive Masters. He won again in 1972 by three strokes. In 1975, Nicklaus won by one stroke in a close contest with Tom Weiskopf and Johnny Miller.

Gary Player became the first non-American to win the Masters in 1961, beating Palmer, the defending champion. In 1974, he won again by two strokes.

Non-Americans collected 11 victories in 20 years in the 1980s and 1990s, by far the strongest run they have had in any of the three majors played in the United States since the early days of the U.S. Open. The first European to win the Masters was Seve Ballesteros in 1980. Nicklaus became the oldest player to win the Masters in 1986 when he won for the sixth time at age 46. Other, European winners during that golden era included Nick Faldo, Jose Maria Olazabal, Bernhard Langer, Ian Woosnam and Sandy Lyle.

At age 21 in 1997, Tiger Woods won the Masters by twelve shots and broke the 72-hole record that had stood for 32 years. Woods completed his "Tiger Slam" by winning his fourth straight major championship at the Masters in 2001. He won again the following year, making him only the third player in history to win the tournament in consecutive years, as well as in 2005 when he defeated Chris DiMarco in a playoff for his first major championship win in almost three years.

The 2003 tournament was won by Mike Weir, who became the first Canadian to win a men's major championship, and the first left-hander to win the Masters. The

following year, another left-hander, Phil Mickelson, won his first major championship by making a birdie on the final hole to beat Ernie Els by a stroke. Mickelson also won the tournament in 2006 and 2010.

In 2011, the tournament was won by South African Charl Schwartzel, who birdied the final four holes to win by two strokes. In 2012, Bubba Watson won the tournament on the second play-off hole. Watson's win marked the fifth time that a left-hander won the Masters in the previous ten tournaments. Prior to 2003, no left-hander had ever won the Masters. The 2013 Masters was won by Adam Scott, the first Australian to win the tournament after many attempts from the great Greg Norman. Watson won the 2014 Masters by three strokes over Jordan Spieth and Jonas Blixt. It was his second Masters victory in three years. In 2015, Spieth would become the second-youngest winner in just his second Masters and twelve months later Sergio Garcia would claim his only Major to date.

In 2019 Tiger Woods won his fifth Green Jacket, and fifteenth major, by one stroke ahead of three runners-up. It left him one shy of Jack Nicklaus' record six Masters win, and three short of his record eighteen major wins. At age 43 he became the second oldest winner, again only bettered by Nicklaus who won at age 46. There was no Masters in 2020 due to Covid-19 while the recent winners have come from Dustin Johnson, Hideki Matsuyama, Jon Rahm (2023) and Scottie Scheffler (2022 and 2024).

In what promises to be a fascinating spectacle over the four days there are high hopes that Rory McIlroy can be a contender. While he has never delivered at Augusta there is no doubt the game is in place to at some point wear the famous jacket.

Starting in Northern Ireland and the province of Ulster home to Major Champions Rory McIlroy, Graeme McDowell and Darren Clarke and renowned for its stunning natural golfing country, Northern Ireland has many spectacular links courses that attract worldwide attention.

In the land of the mythic Giant's Causeway, the Royal Portrush Golf Club joins the top ranked Irish courses in the World and hosted The Open Championship in 2019. The club is located on the world famous Causeway Coast in Co Antrim. Founded in 1888, it has two championship courses – the renowned Dunluce Course and the smaller, but equally enjoyable Valley Course.

Portstewart Golf Club hosted the Dubai Duty Free Irish Open in 2017. Moving to County Limerick which is just a short distance north from Kerry and home to some of the top courses this side of the Shannon.

Adare Manor Golf Club, an 18–hole parkland golf course provides an historic Irish golfing experience. The Desmond Castle (dates back to 1200 AD) is a magnificent backdrop to the 1st and 15th greens, while the ruins of the Franciscan Abbey (1464 AD) dominate the centre of the course.

Carlow is an in–land town offering visitors an exciting array of activities from exhilarating outdoor pursuits, vibrant shopping to spectacular golf courses.

The Mount Wolseley Hotel Spa and Golf Resort is situated in the tranquil countryside of County Carlow, just one hour from Dublin City. Carlow Golf Club itself boasts two courses: with the Championship 18–hole Deerpark course and the 9–hole (Par 35) Oakpark Course which opened in 2002.


is continually featured in Golf World's Top 100 courses in Ireland.





ROLEX GRAND FINAL IN MALLORCA

The HotelPlanner Tour has confirmed that Mallorca's acclaimed Club de Golf Alcanada will host its end-of-season showpiece, the Rolex Grand Final, for the fifth time this Autumn.



aking place from October 30 – November 2, the 2025 Rolex Grand Final will once again be the culmination of the 'Road to Mallorca' – a total of 29 tournaments across 19 countries on Europe's leading developmental tour. Designed by the prolific Robert Trent Jones Jnr, Club de Golf Alcanada's par-72 course is renowned for its difficulty in tournament conditions and ensures that players must be at the top of their game in order to earn one of the 20 career-changing DP World Tour cards on offer.

The coastal venue first hosted the event in 2019, then again from 2022-2024, with all four winners –Francesco Laporta, Nathan Kimsey, Marco Penge and Kristoffer Reitan – currently playing on the DP World Tour.

privilege to host the Rolex Grand Final for the fifth time.

PONTA DO PARGO MADEIRA COURSE NEARS COMPLETION

Six-time Major champion Sir Nick Faldo has lauded the site of his hotly anticipated new course at Ponta do Pargo which is scheduled to open in 2026.

he 30-time DP World Tour winner first set foot on the site – on the westernmost point of Madeira's main island – more than 20 years ago and returned there once again in early 2025 as the construction project nears its final stages.

Scheduled for opening in 2026, the par-72 layout is perched high on the clifftops and boasts spectacular views across the archipelago and out to the Atlantic Ocean. Faldo and his team were challenged to create a course that could be enjoyed by players of all skill levels without sacrificing the dramatic natural landscape and frequent elevation changes that define the site.

Now as the finishing touches are applied, the course's route stretches along the famous Miradouro do Fio before winding back to a strategically located clubhouse with breathtaking panoramic vistas.

Faldo said: "Building on a site with such natural beauty is a golf course designer's dream. It is one of those sites that you could walk a million times and still find yourself lost in the scenery. I walked the land and was instantly playing the course in my mind; I cannot wait to get a club in my hands."

Sustainability has also been at the heart of Ponta do Pargo's development process, with a number of key measures in place to reduce the environmental impact of building and managing the course. The choice to install Madeira's native Kikuyu grass, which is capable of thriving on the climate's natural rainfall alone, is expected to drastically reduce demand for water throughout the year.

Faldo continued: "I have always felt that golf courses need to be designed in a way that protects and showcases the natural flora and fauna - when you get a special site like this, sometimes the hardest part is not tinkering with it too much.



I have been fortunate to work on some spectacular sites around the world, but Ponta do Pargo is in a league of its own.

"The calibre of golf that we are designing combined with the astonishing views only complement the culture and hospitality the region is known for."

Across a glittering career, Faldo won the Open Championship and the Masters Tournament three times each – a feat only achieved by three other players in history. He represented Team Europe in eleven Ryder Cups as a player and once as a captain, winning four times and retaining the trophy with a tie in 1989.

Ponta do Pargo will become the fourth course to draw golfers from across the world to Madeira, joining three more designs by the sport's leading figures: Cabell B. Robinson's Palheiro Golf, perched high above the city of Funchal; Club de Golf Santo da Serra, a 27-hole venue built by legendary architect Robert Trent Jones; and Seve Ballesteros' acclaimed Porto Santo Golfe on the nearby island of Porto Santo.
