eona Maguire became the first Irishwoman to win on the Ladies European Tour (LET) after sinking her eagle putt on the final hole of the Aramco Team Series presented by PIF – London.

The Solheim Cup star led from the first day in the Individual competition at Centurion Club after rounds of 66 (-7) and 72 (-1).

It was an up-and-down day for the Irishwoman who made the turn in twoover par, and she was level on the back nine heading into 18 knowing she needed to make an eagle to secure victory.

Maguire hit an excellent second shot to leave herself with an eagle chance and she duly rolled in the putt to make history on the LET and win with a total of eight-under-par.

"I did it the hard way today, I feel like," said Maguire. "It was tough out there; I didn't play my best golf but Dermot my caddie just kept saying be patient.

"He said right before that shot into 18, let's hit shot of the year here. It was a perfect number, and my trusty hybrids came in useful once again.

"I knew Alison [Lee] was making a run, I thought I would have to get to 10under-par – that was the number I had in my head.

"I just hung in even when things weren't going right and waited for a turn, and it was nice to finish in style on 18.

"I was just trying to hit a good putt! It was a little bit like a Solheim Cup, I knew no Irishwoman had ever won on the LET before. That putt was for me, that putt was for my family and that putt was for Ireland. It was a proud moment."

Spain's Maria Hernandez finished in second place on seven-under-par after a bogey-free final round of 68 (-5).The Spaniard rolled in birdies on holes one, five, 10, 16 and 18 to seal another top-10 finish on the LET in 2024.

"I played very solidly; I didn't really put myself in any trouble during the round," said Hernandez. "I put in a few chances; I didn't make as many only the ones that were very close.

"I made a good putt on 16 that was four metres, but the rest of the day I had good chances that I didn't really make. I was playing good for a long time, but I couldn't really score so the putter has made a big difference."

Three players finished in a share of third place with Ireland's Lauren Walsh, America's Alison Lee and England's Georgia Hall all on six-under-par.

France's Agathe Sauzon ended the week in outright sixth place on five-under with Germany's Laura Fuenfstueck one shot further back.

News PAUL McGINLEY JUNIOR GOLF CUP

Budding golf stars of the future can enjoy an unforgettable experience at Quinta do Lago as Ryder Cup legend Paul McGinley hosts the Paul McGinley Junior Cup 2024. Home to three 18-hole championship golf courses – the North, South and Laranjal – the premier Algarve resort is once again showing its commitment to junior golf by welcoming up to 100 golfers between the ages of nine and 18 to take part in two days of competition from Friday, August 23.

McGinley – who famously holed the winning putt in the 2002 Ryder Cup and led Europe to victory as captain in 2014 – will play host as the event is held for a ninth time. This year, players will enjoy two competitive rounds on the South Course and have the option of playing a practice round on Thursday, August 22. Players – who must all have handicaps – will also get the opportunity to meet McGinley at the presentation evening following the tournament.

Speaking ahead of the event, McGinley said: "I'm really looking forward to hosting another edition of the Paul McGinley Junior Cup at Quinta do Lago.



News McKibbin Set for Amgen Irish Open at Royal County Down



om McKibbin cannot wait to tee it up on home soil later this year when the Amgen Irish Open returns to Royal County Down Golf Club from September 12-15. The Northern Irishman will be making his third appearance in the island of Ireland's national open when the popular event is held in Newcastle for the first time since 2015.

He will join compatriot Rory McIlroy and Irish stars Pádraig Harrington, Shane Lowry and Séamus Power in the field at Royal County Down, globally recognised as one of the world's best golf courses. Last year, McKibbin became the youngest winner from the island of Ireland on the DP World Tour since McIlroy when he claimed the Porsche European Open title. He then went on to make his first appearance as a professional at the Irish Open later that season finishing T39 at The K Club.

The 21-year-old made his Irish Open debut as an amateur at Galgorm Castle Golf Club in 2020 when the event was played behind closed doors, and he now can't wait to experience the home support in full voice later this year.

"When I heard Royal County Down was going to host the Amgen Irish Open in 2024, I knew it was an event I couldn't wait to be a part of," said McKibbin. "It's an incredible golf course and once you're out there you can understand why it's rated so highly by so many."

Last year, Vincent Norrman became the first Swedish winner of the Irish Open for more than 20 years when he triumphed at The K Club, carding a final round 65 to win by one stroke. It was the Swede's second victory in the space of just six worldwide starts. First played in 1927, the Irish Open is one of the world's most celebrated national opens, with an impressive list of former champions that includes Seve Ballesteros, Nick Faldo, Rory McIlroy, Pádraig Harrington, Shane Lowry, Colin Montgomerie, José María Olazábal, Bernhard Langer and Sam Torrance.

In the Team competition, Team Nadaud secured victory over Team Hall after a three-hole playoff at the end of the day.

The captains headed back to the 18th tee as France's Nastasia Nadaud and England's Georgia Hall went head-to-head to win the team title.

Both players made an eagle on the first playoff hole and a birdie on the second playoff hole before Nadaud rolled in her birdie putt on the third to secure victory for her team.

"I don't even know how I handled this! I was so nervous on the first tee," said Nadaud, who is still a teenager. "I was really afraid I wouldn't hit the ball. I was so nervous, I was trembling."

Czechia's Kristyna Napoleaova, who was a winning captain in Hong Kong last year, explained: "We were super nervous on the sidelines, it was amazing to watch both Nas [Nadaud] and Georgia [Hall].

"Both of them played incredible golf, I think everyone here enjoyed the playoff. It was so fun to watch. For it to be eagle-birdie-birdie from those positions. It was incredible, well done to both teams."

"We were so nervous," said Spain's Mireia Prat. "Nastasia played really good and Georgia as well. It was one of the best playoffs and most exciting that I have seen. Yesterday, we played really good, and our amateur George made some good holes."

Amateur George Brooksbank added: "It has been incredible to play with them and to watch and I had every faith, every time Nastasia had the putter in her hand I thought the ball was going into the hole. It was great to be here."

In the LET Order of Merit, Hernandez climbed up to sixth place in the Order of Merit with Walsh now 12th and Maguire has jumped from 134th to 28th place. Onwards and upwards to the KPMG Ladies Irish Open at Carton House for Leona.

Hilton Belfast Templepatrick Golf & Country Club is home to one of the country's finest courses. Designed by the winner of many European pro tournaments, David Jones, in consultation with David Feherty, one of Northern Ireland's most successful golfers, the course makes full use of the spectacular scenery, including streams, rivers and mature trees.



outstanding hole, with a stream meandering its way through it, coming into play for all shots to a severely sloping green.

In keeping with its neighbouring counties County Clare can also lay claim to some of the most challenging and spectacular golf courses in the Mid West region.

One such course is found at Dromoland Castle Golf & Country Club, which is one of the finest 5 star hotels in Ireland and has a golf course to equal the splendour of the setting.

Also, The Inn at Dromoland is recommended and which combines high levels of service, sumptuous dining and new renovated rooms and facilities.

Lahinch Golf Club is a world–renowned links golf course. Founded in 1892 it has often been described as the "St. Andrew's" of Ireland. Lahinch is actually two 18 hole courses, the Old Course, is between the road and the sea, and situated at the opposite side of the road from the Old Course is the Castle Course. The Castle Course is a flatter links named after the ruins of a nearby castle tower that stands to the north of the course.

Moving to the South-East, a golfer's paradise with courses to suit all tastes and skills. Starting in Waterford, Gold Coast Golf Resort welcomes visitors and societies to its parkland by the sea. The 18–hole championship course offers wonderful views of Dungarvan Bay.

Dungarvan Golf Club is a class 18 hole Championship Parkland course located outside the town of Dungarvan, County Waterford. The course is adjacent to Dungarvan Bay and set against the backdrop of the Comeragh mountains.

West Waterford Golf and Country Club designed by the late Eddie Hackett is an 18-hole par 72 championship golf course situated 4km west of Dungarvan. The club is maintained in excellent condition offering superb playability throughout the year. Societies and Visitors are warmly welcomed.

Ireland's only true island golf course surrounded by the River Suir, accessed by complimentary car ferry is Waterford Castle Golf Club which enjoys idyllic seclusion located minutes from Waterford city centre, 90 mins from Dublin and Cork. The 18–hole par 72 Des Smyth designed course, located on the 310–acre private island is ranked in the top 30 parkland courses in Ireland. The Waterford Castle Hotel & Golf Resort is a truly stunning 5 Star experience and a must visit in Ireland's South East.

Waterford Golf Club was founded in 1912 and overlooks the historic city of Waterford. With its magnificent views, this 18–hole parkland course, Par 71, is a gem. The irregular city, with its towers and steeples spread before the eye along the valley, and in the west, Slievenamon and the Comeragh Mountains, make a background of enduring splendor.

Nearby Tramore is a small but charming seaside village twenty minutes from Waterford city. Rathsallagh Golf & Country Club is a Championship Course measuring close to 7,000 yards with a par of 72. Set on 270 acres of rolling parkland. The course is remarkable for the number, position and maturity of the trees on the course and the definition they give on approach to the excellent U.S.G.A specified greens. The bunkering has been described as some of the best in Ireland, both in terms of construction and intelligent placement.

Carlow is an in-land town offering visitors an exciting array of activities from exhilarating outdoor pursuits, vibrant shopping to spectacular golf courses.

The Mount Wolseley Hotel Spa and Golf Resort is situated in the tranquil countryside of County Carlow, just one hour from Dublin City. Carlow Golf Club itself boasts two courses: with the Championship 18–hole Deerpark course and the 9–hole (Par 35) Oakpark Course which opened in 2002.

Also recommended is Carne Golf Links in North Mayo which lies in magnificent unspoiled sand dunes overlooking Blacksod Bay and the wild Atlantic. Carne is an 18-hole, par 72 and was the last links course designed by the late Eddie Hackett.

Further North into Donegal where outstanding golfing venues trip easily off the tongue. While in Donegal you should consider Donegal Golf Club at Murvagh, which is an outstanding links golf course. Designed by the legendary course architect, Eddie Hackett, it is continually featured in Golf World's Top 100 courses in Ireland.

The Abbey Hotel Donegal is renowned for its unique setting and idyllic views, situated in the centre of the beautiful and historic coastal town of Donegal, located on the banks of Donegal Bay.
